Post-Op Care

□Your new implant crown will look, feel, and function like a natural tooth, and require the same level of care. Regular dental appointments, along with good oral hygiene, will help ensure the health and life of your implant crown and natural teeth.

Dr. Yasuhara strongly suggests the following to help protect your investment.

To maintain and monitor implant bone levels, it is strongly recommended that you follow up every 3 months to see the hygienist. We will alternate your routine (cleaning, x-rays, and exam) hygiene visits with a periodontal maintenance visit. This will ensure early detection of bone loss and help maintain healthy bone levels.

Some insurance plans will allow benefits to be paid on these services. Plans that have limitations and / or exclusions of these services are not meant to imply that these services are not needed.

It is also recommended that you purchase an Oral-B Professional Series type of toothbrush. We do have them available for purchase at our office.
